3. Septic and Leach Fields – A Percolation Test will be required in order to obtain a Building Permit and if this Test does not meet New York State Code, an alternate (other than leach field) System will be required.

4. Each co-owner of a property to be subdivided within the Town of Lorraine must sign all application documents and Survey Plats.
